FROM THE RECTOR

Dear St. Paul's Family,

Thank you to all who attended our annual parish meeting in person or online. I have received numerous compliments about the meeting, but those should be directed to Tina, Koji, and Jonathan! They did the heavily lifting and put everything together. If you missed the meeting, here are a few things you probably need to know:

1. Koji Torihara is the new Senior Warden (2022-2024). Archie Carty stepped down at the end of December as Junior Warden. Jay Chandra was nominated to fill the remainder of Archie's term, and this was passed by the parish. Sherian Lammey, Suzgo Nyirenda, and Br. Kirt Gerber, OSB were elected to the vestry to serve from 2022-2025.

2. Both I and this parish owe a great deal of gratitude to Father Kemp for his time as priest-in-charge during the transition. **We are collecting a purse to give to Fr. Kemp. Please make checks payable to St. Paul's and put Fr. Kemp in the memo line. Checks need to be in by February 15.**
3. The mass schedule has been in a little bit of flux for reasons beyond anyone's control. To that end this should be the final mass schedule for a while:

Mondays – No Mass
Tuesdays – 10:30a (1928 BCP) – Fr Garland
Wednesdays – 10:30a (1928 BCP) – Fr Garland
Thursdays – 6:15p (1979 BCP Rite II) in All Souls' Chapel – Fr Garland
Fridays – No Mass
Saturdays – 9:00a (1928 BCP) – Fr Kemp or Fr Higginbotham

Provided I have a priest to cover the Saturday mass, it will continue to be offered. In the event we do not have a priest to cover Saturday mass, I will send word out in my Thursday email.

4. Speaking of emails—Please make certain that you are receiving and reading the emails that come from the parish. I try to send out only one email a week unless there is a death or major schedule change.
5. I spoke with Bishop Knudsen, our provisional bishop, and have received permission to make Bishop Martins (retired of Springfield) our bishop in residence. Bishop Martins will occasionally be the preacher and presider at mass but will also fulfil all sacramental roles normally done by a bishop. This agreement will need to be re-done when a new diocesan bishop is ordained.
6. Finally, and perhaps most importantly, please consider serving on one of our ministries. Altar Guild and Sunday School both need people to help out with their ministries. I am also in need of servers for the 8:00a Sunday morning mass. If you're interested in helping out the altar guild, please get in touch with Jenny Glick. If you're interested in helping out with Sunday School (the littles are the ones we need help with right now!) please get in touch with Amanda Torihara. If you're interested in serving for 8:00a mass, please get in touch with me!

May the saints pray for us and may Christ bless our ministry.
