FROM THE RECTOR

St. Paul's Family,

This past Sunday the vestry met and a decision has been made that needs to be communicated to everyone. Going forward, we will not permit people to sell things at St. Paul's unless 1) it is children (girl scouts, etc.) or 2) unless it directly impacts the parish life (gift shop, luncheon tickets, etc.). This keeps us mindful of the purpose of God's house. The vestry has also been working through the process of making changes in order to get us up to date with standard business practices of the Episcopal Church and canon law.

Along with that, I would ask both services—8 and 10:30—to be mindful of people who are in church early to pray. When it is 5 minutes until the start of mass, please refrain from talking to allow those who wish to pray the ability to do so. The good news is that the coffee hour after 10:30 am has returned! So please join us up in Banner Hall for fellowship after the principal service.

I will be away from after mass on May 1 until May 16ish—my return flight keeps changing with alarming regularity. From May 2 until May 18, the daily mass schedule will be condensed to Wednesday at 10:30 am and Saturday at 9:00 am, and of course both 8 am and 10:30 am on Sundays. The normal mass schedule will resume on May 18 at 10:30 am. My thanks to Fr Kemp for minding the store whilst I am away.

Fr Heschl̄e will be returning to St. Paul's on June 1. I am profoundly thankful to him for making my transition to St. Paul's easy and for answering a myriad of questions since my arrival.

Please consider either joining the Hospitality Committee or hosting a coffee hour! Funds are being made available to those who host a coffee hour, and it doesn't need to be elaborate.

Finally—a reminder that the Feast of the Ascension of our Lord is Thursday May 26. It is a principal feast of the church (on par with Easter, Christmas, All Saints', Trinity, Pentecost, The Epiphany). Mass will be at 7:00 pm in the Church and is considered a day of holy obligation.
