St. Paul's Family,

There will be no weekday masses on: Tuesday May 9, Wednesday May 10, Thursday May 11, Tuesday May 16, Tuesday May 23, Wednesday May 24, Thursday May 25, Tuesday May 30, and Wednesday May 31.
