**Communion** (*sit*)

*Cantor* Verily I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray: believe that ye receive them, and it shall be done unto you.

All baptized Christians who have been admitted to Holy Communion, are repentant of their sins, and believe in the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament are welcome to receive Communion. Reception of the host will be in the right hand palm only today. If you do not intend to receive, you may instead come up for a blessing—simply cross your arms over your chest.

After receiving Communion or a blessing at the altar rail, parents may bring their children through the west side aisle to the Library for Sunday School.
